1. What is Foursquare Senior Living?

2. Why is Foursquare Foundation developing senior housing?

Foursquare Foundation was founded with funds from the sale of radio station KFSG to “accelerate worldwide interdenominational evangelism.” Each year Foursquare Foundation funds projects that win souls for Christ, plant churches, make disciples, develop leaders and accelerate the mission of The Foursquare Church.

Foursquare Foundation explored the development of senior housing as a good investment strategy, given the growing market need that's being driven by the retirement of the baby boomer generation.

By accelerating the growth of the corpus of Foursquare Foundation through appreciating assets, more ministry and missions will be resourced nationally and internationally.

3. How will Foursquare Senior Living be funded?

Foursquare Senior Living is funded through the Foursquare Foundation corpus and will not use any tithe funds or general operating funds of The Foursquare Church. Property already owned by The Foursquare Church will be used to develop senior residential communities in various locations throughout the United States.

4. What is Parkview Living?

Parkview Living is the first Foursquare Senior Living community; it is located in Echo Park, across from Angelus Temple where The Foursquare Church began. There are 75 apartment homes with one-bedroom/one-bath or two-bedroom/two-bath layouts. A vibrant community center where chapel services will be held will promote a rich spiritual life.
